

- \triangleright Became a month-long celebration in <u>1976</u>.
- ➤ The month of February was chosen to coincide with the birthdays of <u>Frederick Douglass</u> and <u>Abraham Lincoln</u>.





AFRICAN/BLACK ROYALTY




King Tut (Tutankhamun)

- > Egyptian Pharaoh
- Began his reign at 9 yrs. old
- Ruled at the end of 18th dynasty btw, C. 1332-1323 BC



Nefertiti (the beautiful woman has come)

- Egyptian Queen btwn 1353 to 1336 BCE
- Reigned over possibly the wealthiest period in Ancient Egyptian
- Rumored to have possibly ruled as a Pharaoh
- ► Wise boyond measure




Mansa Musa (wealthiest man on earth)

- West African King
- ➤ 10th Ruler of **Mali Empire**—one of the largest empires in the world (c. 1235 to 1670)
- Legendary Pilgrimage to Mecca

Trans-Atlantic Slave Trade

- Displaced millions of African people from their homeland
- Was created for capital gain and to build America
- Was an atrocious era that lasted for hundreds of years
- Inflicted insurmountable pain and suffering on millions of black bodies
- Produced incredibly strong and determined survivors






SPOTLIGHT A HERO

George Washington Carver

- ❖ Born to enslaved farmers in 1864
- 1ST African American student at Iowa's Simpson College to earn a degree in agriculture science
 - Developed hundreds of products from farm plants
 - **❖** An amazing inventor and scientist
 - ❖ Passed away in 1943
